## What products WILL be accepted?

Bring in your obsolete or unwanted agricultural pesticides in a secure container with the product label attached. If there is no label, identify the container as 'unknown pesticide' and ensure that containers are not leaking.

## What products WILL NOT be accepted?

Adjuvants, treated seed, paint, solvents, domestic pesticides or other domestic hazardous wastes will not be accepted. Please contact your local municipality for disposal options for these products.
